

ABOUT THE WRITERS



Jeffrey Hatcher is an American playwright and screenwriter. The writer of dozens of plays, Sierra Madre Playhouse previously produced his adaptation of *Tuesdays with Morrie*. His many award-winning original plays have been performed on Broadway, Off-Broadway, and regionally across the US and abroad. Hatcher is a member and/or alumnus of The Playwrights' Center, The Dramatists Guild of America,

Writers Guild of America and New Dramatists. Hatcher developed the adaptation of *The Turn of the Screw* with the Portland Stage Company as part of its Little Festival of the Unexpected program in 1995, and it debuted at the company's home theater in Portland, Maine on January 11, 1996.

Henry James (April 15, 1843 – February 28, 1916) was an American-British author. James was nominated for the Nobel Prize in Literature in 1911, 1912, and 1916. He is best known for his novels dealing with the social and marital interplay between émigré Americans, the English, and continental Europeans. His 1898 horror novella *The Turn of the Screw*, which first appeared in serial format in *Collier's Weekly*, has garnered a reputation as the



most analyzed and ambiguous ghost story in the English language and remains his most widely adapted work in other media.



Gary directed CHARLOTTE'S WEB and EVERY CHRISTMAS STORY EVER TOLD here at SMP, for which he received a Scenie Award for Directing and Choreography (and for which Cate Caplin also won a Choreography award for choreographing the very funny Nutcracker Ballet in that show). Gary has done his share of Shakespeare roles over the years as well as directing many different productions. Gary was Co-Artistic Director for Crown City Theater for 12 years for whom the production of CABARET he directed, ran for 6 months and was listed as Best Production by BitterLemons and Broadwayworld as well as grabbing Scenie Awards for Outstanding Production, Ensemble, and Direction of a Musical. Gary has written, produced, acted and directed for professional live theater going on 42 years and has been seen on TV and film as well as having written and directed several short films. He's a songwriter and has an album of country music out called Beyond Repair by G.B. Lamb.
